

The performance highlights of the Department of Heavy Industry for the month of December, 2011:-

I Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd. (BHEL)

Order booking:

The total order receipts in the current financial year up-to December, 2011 has reached a level of **Rs. 15,889 Crores**. Significant orders received during the month include:

❖ Industry business Sector:
