
**NOTIFICATION**

- S.O.....(E) – Whereas, the Department of Heavy Industry notified the scheme namely FAME-India (Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of (Hybrid &) Electric Vehicles in India ) vide S.O.830 (E) dated 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2015.
2. And whereas, the Phase-I of the FAME-India Scheme was for two years i.e. FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17 which commenced from 1<sup>st</sup>.April, 2015.
3. And whereas, the Phase-I of the FAME-India Scheme was further extended for a further period of six months i.e. upto 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 or till approval of Phase-II, whichever is earlier, vide S.O.1055 (E) dated 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2017.
4. Now therefore the period of the FAME-India Scheme is further extended for a further period of six months i.e. upto 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2018 or till launching of Phase-II of the Scheme by NITI Aayog, whichever is earlier.
5. Therefore, FAME-India [Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of (Hybrid&) Electric Vehicles in India] scheme notification vide S.O. 830(E) dated 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 and S.O.1055 (E) dated 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2017 stands amended accordingly.
